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Entry Information

All entries are via the Sport Event Management System (SEMS). Individuals and teams should request entry to the carnival through their club contact and entries are submitted at club level.

Late entries close 5pm Wednesday 5th February 2025.

Please remind everyone to bring their Live Heats wristbands!

If you are having issues entering a member into SEMS, things to check;

- Is the member registered for 2024/25 season?
- Does the member have the correct award for their age division? (U15 = SRC, U17+ = BM) →
Is this award current? Check the proficiency expiry date in Surfguard.
- Does the member have their competition rights with your Club or could it be with another Club?

Event Information & Eligibility

- All competitors must be financial members and meet the proficiency requirement relating to their age group. Namely, U15 - Surf Rescue Certificate (CPR Endorsed) and U17 to Opens/Masters - Bronze Medallion.
- Please note, Under 14 competitors with SRC are eligible to compete in team events only. Under 15 members can only compete in the U15 age category and are not permitted to also participate in U17 or Open events.
- Mixed Events refer to a team with at least one female and any combination of age category specified in the event name unless stipulated otherwise.
- A maximum of 3 teams per Club per event. Composite teams are allowable on the day, no points will be awarded.
