Participants will be involved in physical challenges, discussions, activities and scenarios that require leadership, teamwork and communication. Under 13 and 14 candidates, leaders (past program participants) and parent helpers are encouraged to attend.

#### **Eligible Candidates**

- All candidates must be current financial members
- Successfully completed the Surf Rescue Certificate (this will be verified via Surf Guard) or be 13 years of age and completed the Pool Assessment of the SRC (200m in 5 minutes). *See appendix 1*
- Candidates must have turned 13 by 10<sup>th</sup> April 2026.

***Please upload swim Assessment into JotForm. ONLY required if SRC is not complete***

**Eligible Leaders**

Wambiri Leaders are those that are 14-15 years of age (past participants are welcome) and must have completed at minimum their Surf Rescue Certificate (SRC). All leaders must be current financial members and up to date with their proficiency.

**Parent Helpers**

Participating clubs are required to supply at least **1 Parent per 5 kids** from each club to stay and assist with supervision, with a minimum of 1 female parent helper to supervise female candidates and leaders.

All Parent helpers are to use the Wambiri Online Application Form to enter their details: **WAMBIRI 2026**

All adults must be current financial members and their Member Protection details (Working with Children Check) verified by their club in Surfguard.

It is a legal requirement for all volunteers attending a camp and who are supervising the children overnight to have a Working with Children Check validated. It is also advised that all volunteers in attendance should undertake the SLS Safeguarding Children and Young People Awareness module before departure.

**Club Responsibilities**

Clubs will be asked to endorse members once applications have been received. Clubs are responsible for collecting fees from their candidates.

**Code of Conduct**

All parents and program participants are advised that for the safety and enjoyment of all attendees, all rules and instructions are to be followed in order to;

- provide a safe environment for everyone involved
- to take an inclusive approach in its activities
- to ensure the safety and wellbeing of all attendees

Any candidates or leaders who are found to be jeopardising the safety and enjoyment of others will have their parents contacted, requesting that they be collected.

**Medical Information**

Due to Australian Government legislation, Surf Life Saving New South Wales and Far South Coast Surf Life Saving Inc cannot cover medical expenses. These can only be claimed through a medical fund. Accordingly, medical expenses incurred during the program are the participant's responsibility.

**Sleeping Arrangements**

The Pambula SLSC clubhouse is the accommodation venue. All attendees will be required to bring their own bedding; swag, stretcher or blow up mattress which is to be setup on the floor. Each gender will be grouped together and separated on the different levels of the building (upstairs/downstairs).

**Transport Arrangements**

Each participant is responsible for arranging transport to and from Pambula SLSC. Whilst participating in the program, parent helpers/program coordinators will be asked to transport attendees to and from certain activities in private vehicles. Drivers' licenses will be sighted by the DOMS.
